How to connect your PS5 to RESNET_WIFI

Step 1 Find the MAC address for your PS5 so that you can register your device and obtain a password to connect to RESNET_WIFI.

To do this connect the device as advised by PlayStation and go into the 'Settings' menu. Once in the 'Settings' area, please follow these instructions:

Scroll down to and select 'Network'.

Step 2 Registering your device to obtain a RESNET_WIFI password

You now need to register your PS5 to obtain the password needed to connect your PS5 to RESNET_WIFI.

To do this, use your mobile phone/tablet/laptop, ensure you can connect to the internet and have set up eduroam wi-fi on this device using these instructions on <u>MySurrey</u>.

On your mobile phone/tablet/laptop, visit <u>managemydevices.surrey.ac.uk</u> to register your PS5 and generate the password you need to connect the PS5 to RESNET_WIFI. Click <u>here</u> for instructions on how to register your device.

Remember, if you have more than one device you would like to connect to RESNET-WIFI, you will need to register each device and obtain a password for each one.

Once you have noted down the RESNET_WIFI password, return to your PS5 and follow the on-screen instructions to connect to RESNET_WIFI.

Step 3 Connecting your device to the RESNET_WIFI

On your PS5, move back from the 'View Connection Status' screen to the 'Network' screen.

On the Network screen, scroll to Settings on the left and then select 'Set Up Internet Connection'.

When the test is complete, you will be connected to RESNET_WIFI. Your PS5 is ready to use.

Despite your phone/laptop/tablet being connected to eduroam and your PS5 being connected to RESNET_WIFI, casting will still work between these networks. There is no need to connect your phone/laptop/tablet to RESNET_WIFI for this to work.
